Our current food system is a leading cause of some of the biggest challenges the world is facing, from climate change, resource depletion and waste, to malnutrition, disease and obesity.

Our EIT-labelled Learning Services for employers provide a comprehensive methodology and toolkit to support the upskilling and reskilling of staff in innovation competencies. The services allow tailor-made solutions to support HR and line managers while driving impact throughout clients' organisations.

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Our professional education portfolio includes programmes in entrepreneurship, leadership, food systems approaches and deep technical trainings which are not available through traditional providers of education and training in the food system. Examples are WE Lead, for women leaders, the Innovator Fellowship, for researchers, and Algal Biotech, for technical staff.

THE REGENERATIVE

Our online courses have helped over 130,000 learners understand the food system, how to make better food choices and how technologies can contribute to sustainability. The Regenerative Agriculture Revolution is our newest addition and explores sustainable farming methods.



OUR ACTIVITIES – INNOVATION

PHENOLIVA – an EIT Award nominee and EIT Food Impact Award winner – is combatting food waste in the olive oil industry. Using a novel process, antioxidants from olive pomace are extracted and processed into an innovative food antioxidant.

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BREEZE is bringing a prevention and control system for sea lice management to market, developed with the environment, fish welfare, food safety and farm economics in mind. It will enable the successful scaling of sustainably managed fish farms, to meet the growing demand for healthy proteins.

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TASTE2MEAT contributes to a zero-waste and sustainable food system by developing hybrid (meat & plant protein) and fully plant protein-based meat alternatives using underutilised sources, such as sunflower press-cake. Focusing on flavour and structure and co-creating with consumers, the project is delivering tasty alternatives that meet consumer demands.

OUR ACTIVITIES – ENTREPRENEURSHIP

We support innovative impactful entrepreneurs and startups to deliver new food innovations and businesses across Europe



Hai develops tools that enable vertical farmers to consistently produce high-quality crops without the need for manual monitoring. Through Seedbed, HAI has built and validated its proof of concept, and organised trial collaborations with the connections made from the programme.

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EIT Food Accelerator Network alum uFraction8 designs filters to help biomanufacturers harvest products such as cultured meat with energy-efficient, affordable and scalable systems. With the help of FAN, uFraction8 secured two industrial pilot trails and was awarded €100,000 to help scale its solutions.

Deep Planet's VineSignal is a satellite and Albased solution that reduces vineyard variability, monitors yield and improves crop quality, helping winegrowers adapt to the increasing impact of climate change. As part of the Rising-FoodStars network, Deep Planet partnered to help more growers adapt to changing weather conditions.

CITIZEN PARTICIPATION FORUM (CPF)

Putting consumers at the heart of our activities, the CPF provides EIT Food with key consumer insights - needs, wants, perceptions, concerns, intentions - around food products and the food system. The CPF reports, such as demand for algae-based products, have helped us gain a deeper understanding of consumer attitudes.

Through the website in 3 languages, 20 million+ engagements on social media and in-person dialogues between the public, academia, policymakers, startups and industry, FoodUnfolded[®] creates a new solution-focused culture around food.

The Food Educators project provides children with the knowledge to make sustainable and healthy dietary choices and brings agrifood career opportunities closer to secondary school students.

Our annual flagship policy event provides an opportunity to shape the transition of the European food system. Sessions are focussed on future trends and priorities in European food innovation, in line with the UN SDGs and the EU Farm to Fork Strategy. Ultimately, the shared goal among delegates is to achieve a European policy framework that can deliver healthy and sustainable food for all.

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WHITEPAPER PROTEIN DIVERSIFICATION

Protein diversification is one of the keys to unlocking rapid and deep change in the food system. In this whitepaper we highlight the state of technological developments, the business and societal potential of diversifying the proteins we produce and eat. Given our focus on impact, it also identifies needs and opportunities in research and innovation to further accelerate this growing strategic sector.

We regularly share our knowledge and expertise via position papers - the result of consultations with our community. A recent example is the Blue Bioeconomy paper, produced to inform on how to scale up the sustainable production of algae-based products, ensure their safe consumption and boost their innovative use. This paper ensures that views from across the food value chain will feed into the EU Algae Strategy.



OUR ACTIVITIES IN NORTH & EAST

EMPOWERING WOMEN IN AGRIFOOD (EWA)

EWA has supported 260 female entrepreneurs from 15 Eastern and Southern European countries with tailored training, mentorship, and networking opportunities. Going into its 3rd year, the project culminated in the first Women in Agrifood Summit in December 2022. EWA has helped Giedre Kesiunaite, EWA 2021 1st prize winner from Lithuania, develop a clear path for her startup and join Seedbed, while 2nd Prize winner from Lithuania Milda Savickaitė continues her entrepreneurial journey with EIT Food Accelerator Network.

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MICROCAPSULES FOR NUTRITION AND PROTECTION

Croatian-based startup MAKABI develops microcapsules for plant nutrition and protection for agroecological agriculture, reducing the usage of fertilisers. They came second in TeamUp 2022, our programme that finds and matches brilliant technologists with compatible business entrepreneurs and supports them on their journey to co-create truly impactful agrifood ventures.

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Recent shocks, including the COVID-19 pandemic and the war in Ukraine, revealed the vulnerabilities within Europe's food supply chains. As a response, the New AgVentures programme launched in 2023 for companies in Central-Eastern Europe to better understand trends, look for solutions to make their supply chain more resilient, and learn from their peers. The kick-off event, CEE Agrifood decarb, provided knowledge and skills to help companies in their decarbonisation efforts.



OUR ACTIVITIES IN SOUTH

CROSS-SECTOR ACTION ON WATER SCARCITY

Water scarcity is one of the major challenges threatening the sustainability of Europe's food system. This is a particular issue in Southern European countries. To improve the region's water resources, the Water Scarcity project carries out a series of activities – from supporting scaleups and SMEs that tackle water-related challenges and creating a community of experts, to fostering the adoption of a water saving culture in Europe.

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EDIBLE FOOD COATINGS

Spanish startup Bio2Coat secured a place in the 2020 Seedbed Incubator Bilbao and won the Venture Summit award for a net-zero food system in 2022 with their edible food coating products. Made entirely from natural sources, the coatings can be applied to food products to preserve and extend their shelf life. They are colourless, flavourless and fragrance-free, and can be consumed together with the food product without changing its sensory characteristics.

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WOMEN-LED ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The Supernovas project offers coaching and training opportunities for women to take their managerial and leadership skills to the next level. Dedicated activities support female-led startups to enter new European markets and women starting their careers in venture investment. By creating a support system for female investors and entrepreneurs, we are actively bringing more women into these sectors and addressing the gender imbalance.



OUR ACTIVITIES IN WEST

OPPORTUNITIES FOR CONTROLLED ENVIRONMENT AGRICULTURE

From a ploughed field to a high-tech greenhouse with artificial lighting, producers exert varying degrees of control over plant growth conditions in every type of crop production system. In this report, we explore the barriers and opportunities for controlled environment agriculture in urban, semi-rural and rural areas in Iceland, Ireland and The United Kingdom.

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NEW OUTLETS

Together with Growzer, EIT Food West launched an online circular marketplace – Get Wasted – that creates new outlets for food surpluses from different actors in the value chain. The project was piloted at Belgian schools, offering students healthy soups from surplus vegetables. Additional support from the Flanders Circular Grant and Flemish Food Strategy, will allow Get Wasted to continue to shape the circular economy in Flanders and beyond.
